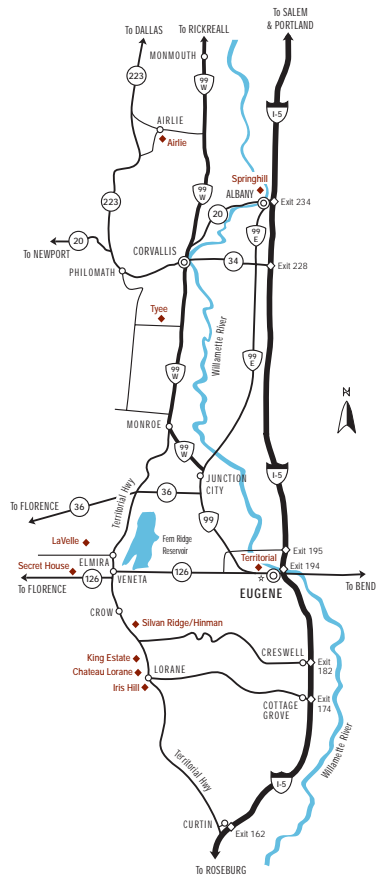

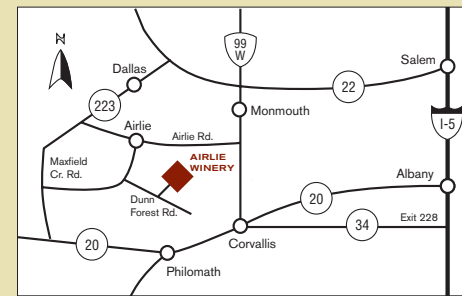

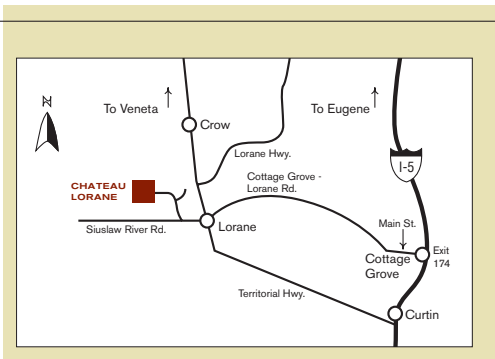

Linde and Sharon Kester planted their 30-acre vineyard in 1984, one mile north of Lorane. The winery and tasting room opened in 1992, producing a wide range of red and white wines, dry, off-dry and sweet, late harvest and mead wines, a port and a number of wines from organically grown grapes. A collection of "rare, unusual, and exotic" varieties such as Melón de Bourgogne, Viognier, Huxelrebe, Maréchal Foch, Baco noir, Pinot meunier, Cascade, Chancellor, Gamay noir, Grignolino and Durif are carefully vinified in small batches producing wines of great distinction. Discover the beauty of the tasting room and picnic area overlooking a private 25-acre lake surrounded by magnificent fir-covered hills. Special events facilities available for up to 300 people.

Iris Hill is nestled in the Lorane Valley, about 15 miles southwest of Eugene. Early each spring, wild Irises cover our hillsides, harbingers of the annual renewal of grapevines. The family owned 40-acre vineyard contributes 100 per cent of the grapes that go into making these complex and wonderful Pinot noir, Pinot gris and Chardonnay wines. The first block of wines was planted in 1993. The family has been involved with the crafting and evolution of Iris Hill wines ever since.
